3. In the spirit of Christian love, commit to being peaceful, and polite, in word and deed. Any misconduct from agitators should be met with silence.
4. Do not respond to agitators. Please stay silent and your response to any situation will be appropriate.
5. Our mission today is to stand against the inequality of the Equality Act and not to confront agitators.
6. Pick up any trash near you before leaving today. We want the public to know we are good stewards of our community.
